The WISTA 45-N camera was designed for ease of use and portability. The total weight of the camera being only five pounds, it is extremely portable and ideal for field or hand-held use.

The 45-N camera is very sturdily built. All of the major parts of the camera are aluminum-alloy die cast or skillfully tooled metal. The roughness of the 45-N camera makes it ideal for the back-packer or out-doors photographer.

The WISTA 45-N camera has full movements, both front and back, which allows for the correction of perspective and the creation of depth of field. The abundant variable movements present on the 45-N camera makes it suited for almost any field or studio use.

The design of the 45-N simplifies handling and use of the camera. The variable swing and tilt movements can be easily set. This enables pictures to be taken quickly and in focus.

The 45-N camera accepts most of the accessories designed for the more sophisticated D, SP, & RF cameras. Thus this camera is a complete systems camera as well as all its other virtues.
